## Returning your ballot by mail:

- ✓ Mark your ballot and place it in the return envelope
- ✓ Sign the affidavit on the return envelope
- ✓ Place a First Class stamp on the return envelope
- ✓ Mail it on, or before, November 2, 2015 (Ballots postmarked later than this cannot be counted)

## Returning your ballot in person:

- ✓ Mark your ballot and place it in the return envelope
- ✓ Sign the affidavit on the return envelope
- ✓ Place your ballot in the secure drop box at your nearest City Hall, the Weber Center, or the Ogden Valley Library
  - Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, October 6<sup>th</sup> - November 3<sup>rd</sup> - Closed Columbus Day Oct. 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Deliver your ballot to your nearest City Hall or the Ogden Valley Library on Election Day, November 3<sup>rd</sup>



**By Mail Ballots must be postmarked no later than November 2nd**
