## COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT - SPRING 2026

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training program provides participants with information about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area. It teaches basic disaster response skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, disaster psychology, and basic disaster medical operations.

CERT training is divided into two parts.

1. 9 online, self-paced Independent Study modules
  - Approximately 9 hours
  - No cost
2. 4 in-person, hands-on classes
  - Thursdays **April 16, 23, 30 and May 7** from 6:00-9:00 PM
  - \$40 fee, CERT supplies provided upon course completion

Participants must complete the Independent Study and attend all in-person classes to receive CERT Certification. The Independent Study must be completed before in-person classes begin.
