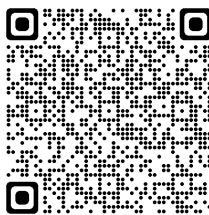
Start and complete the online training, print your certificate and bring it to the hands-on, practical portion of the training. Once the practical portion is completed you will be issued an official certificate of course completion.

- ♦ **You will need to complete the on-line training prior to the first day of the in-class, hands-on course.**

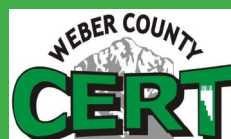
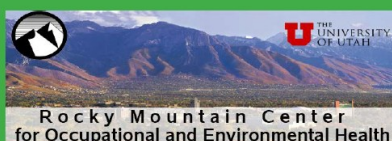
