

**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR INDIGENT DEFENSE ATTORNEY
JUVENILE COURT**

This Amendment, by and between Weber County (“County”), a political subdivision of the State of Utah, and Rebecca Voymas (“Attorney”) (collectively referred to as the “Parties”), amends and modifies the Parties’ Agreement for Indigent Defense Attorney in District Court.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Attorney has a contract with County to represent indigent defendants in district court (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, County has received grant funding from the Indigent Defense Commission to hire an attorney to handle juvenile delinquency and detention hearings;

WHEREAS, Attorney is desirous to accept the additional assignments pursuant to the terms of this amendment;

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, it is agreed between the Parties as follows:

1. Paragraph 1 of the parties’ Agreement shall be modified to include the following:
 - d. **Juvenile Detention Hearings:** Attorney agrees to appear at juvenile detention hearings at the Weber County Juvenile Detention Center (or any other location should the current procedure change). Attorney will interview those juveniles who are present for the detention hearings and represent them on the issue of detention and any other issue before the court at that particular hearing.

2. Paragraph 23 of the parties’ Agreement shall be modified as follows:

County agrees to pay Attorney the following amounts annually:

Basis for Amount	Amount
Juvenile Court Child Welfare Calendars	\$77,157
Juvenile Court Delinquency and Detention Hearings	\$19,000
Total	\$96,157

Payments shall be made to the Attorney in equal monthly installments of \$8,013.08 per month. The first installment at this rate is due before the end of July 2021 and a like sum on the last day of each month thereafter until this agreement expires or is terminated.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Parties Agreement for Indigent Defense Attorney in Juvenile Court shall remain unchanged.




