**A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF 2026 MUNICIPAL TAX REVENUES TO OGDEN VALLEY CITY**

**WHEREAS**, on January 11, 2023, the statutory process to incorporate Ogden Valley City (the “City”) was initiated pursuant to Utah Code Title 10, Chapter 2a; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 5, 2024, the voters residing within the proposed boundaries of the City approved the incorporation; and

**WHEREAS**, following the incorporation election, the statutory process for organizing and establishing the new municipality continued, including the election of municipal officers, transition planning, and coordination of municipal services with Weber County (the “County”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Lieutenant Governor issued a certificate of incorporation for the City on January 2, 2026, and the final local entity plat was subsequently recorded; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the City have worked cooperatively and in good faith throughout the incorporation process to ensure continuity of municipal services and an orderly transition of governmental responsibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County finds that continued support of an orderly transition serves an important public purpose and promotes the health, safety, and welfare of residents within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Utah Code Ann. § 10-2a-219 requires counties to share certain taxes and service charges with newly incorporated municipalities on a pro rata basis beginning on the effective date of incorporation and further authorizes the sharing of additional revenues and services to facilitate the transition of municipal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the County further finds that transferring the 2026 municipal tax revenues attributable to property located within the City will assist the new municipality in establishing operations, funding essential services, and successfully transitioning responsibilities to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, rather than dividing the 2026 municipal tax revenues on a strict pro rata basis, the Weber County Commission desires to transfer the full amount of the 2026 municipal tax revenues attributable to property located within the City in order to support the successful establishment of the new municipality and continuity of municipal services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County that, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-2a-219, the County shall transfer to the City the full amount of the 2026 municipal tax revenues attributable to property located within the municipal boundaries of the City.
