Summary:

The Weber County Solid Waste Division is requesting a fee ordinance amendment for the purpose of reducing the construction and demolition waste fee and creating a household hazardous waste fee at the Weber County Transfer Station. The construction and demolition fee was raised to \$46.10 per ton a few years ago in an attempt to encourage use of the County's construction and demolition landfill near Little Mountain. The Transfer Station now has the equipment and transportation available to handle more material. This fee reduction from \$46.10 to \$40.49 per ton, which matches the general waste fee, will encourage additional use of the Transfer Station and alleviate disputes about the rate that should be charged for mixed loads. This action is consistent with other local transfer stations which have construction and demolition waste fees that are less than or equal to general waste fees.

Last year the Transfer Station spent \$92,219 disposing of household hazardous waste (HHW) like paint, chemicals, and similar products. The \$5 fee per load of HHW will help cover the disposal costs.

FEE ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE WEBER COUNTY TRANSFER STATION (Sec 16-2-9 Solid Waste Fees)

WHEREAS, the Weber County Transfer Station currently charges different fees for general waste and construction and demolition waste; and

WHEREAS, the Weber County Transfer Station is proposing to lower the construction and demolition waste fee from \$46.10 to \$40.49 per ton, which matches the general waste fee; and

WHEREAS, the Weber County Transfer Station is proposing to add a household hazardous waste fee of \$5 per load; and

WHEREAS, these fee adjustments are intended to improve operational efficiencies and cover costs for services provided at the Weber County Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County has determined to support such fee changes; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Title 16, Chapter 2, Section 9 of the Weber County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:
