

**ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT FOR INDIGENT DEFENSE ATTORNEY
IN JUVENILE COURT**

This Addendum, by and between Weber County ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Utah, and Rebecca M. Voymas ("Attorney") (collectively referred to as the "Parties"), amends and modifies the Parties' Agreement for Indigent Defense Attorney in Juvenile Court.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Attorney has a contract with County to represent indigent defendants in juvenile court in both child welfare and delinquency proceedings ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, as a result of new requirements imposed by the State Legislature and the juvenile court, Attorney has agreed to take on the additional assignment of representing juvenile defendants in detention hearings one morning each week;

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed between the Parties as follows:

1. Paragraph 23 of the parties' Agreement shall be modified as follows:

County agrees to pay Attorney the following amounts annually:

Basis for Amount	Amount
Juvenile Court Child Welfare Calendars	\$75,092
Juvenile Detention Hearings	\$2,625
Total	\$77,717

Payment shall be made to the Attorney in equal monthly installments of \$6,476.42 per month. The first installment is due before the end of May 2020 and a like sum on the last day of each month thereafter until this agreement expires or is terminated.

Attorney's compensation is based on the number of years Attorney has practiced. County agrees to increase the compensation paid under this Agreement each year. Increases shall be in an amount determined by County and shall be based on the amount of the increase that County employees receive for that same year.

2. The following paragraph shall be added to the contract.

Juvenile Detention Hearings: Attorney agrees to appear at juvenile detention hearings at the Weber County Juvenile Detention Center (or any other location should the current procedure change). Attorney will interview those juveniles who are present for the detention hearings and represent them on the issue of detention and any other issue before the court at that particular hearing.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Parties Agreement for Indigent Defense Attorney in Juvenile Court shall remain unchanged.
