**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
WEBER COUNTY ADOPTING THE WEBER COUNTY BUSINESS RECRUITMENT,
EXPANSION, AND DEVELOPMENT POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County (the "Commission") recognizes the importance of fostering economic growth, business recruitment, expansion, and site development within unincorporated areas of Weber County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission seeks to establish a clear and structured approach to economic development, ensuring efficient coordination between Weber County departments, regional economic organizations, and state partners; and

WHEREAS, the Weber County Business Recruitment, Expansion, and Development Policy (the "Policy") provides a comprehensive framework for business engagement, site development, and utilization of public finance tools and incentives to support economic expansion and infrastructure development; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this policy will enhance Weber County's ability to attract new businesses, support existing enterprises, and promote sustainable economic growth, thereby improving the quality of life for Weber County residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County as follows:

1. **Adoption of Policy:** The Policy, as set forth in Exhibit A, is hereby adopted as an official economic development policy of Weber County.
2. **Implementation and Administration:** The Weber County Economic Development Director, in coordination with the Weber County Community Development Department, shall oversee the implementation and administration of the Policy.
3. **Coordination with Regional and State Partners:** Weber County shall continue to collaborate with the Northern Utah Economic Alliance (NUEA), Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity (GOEO), Economic Development Corporation of Utah (EDCUtah), and other relevant entities to ensure the effective execution of the Policy.
4. **Public Finance Tools and Incentives:** The Weber County Economic Development Finance Committee shall be responsible for evaluating and recommending the appropriate use of public finance tools, including Public Infrastructure Districts (PIDs), Community Reinvestment Areas (CRAs), and Tax Increment Financing (TIF).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
