MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered by and between Weber County (Recipient Entity) and the State of Utah, Department of Public Safety (DPS), stating the obligations that govern the receipt of appropriated money that is intended to pass through DPS to the Recipient Entity.

PURPOSE

This MOA is to implement the provisions of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-6b-201, which requires a written agreement between a state agency and a recipient entity for money appropriated by the Utah Legislature to the state agency that is intended to be passed through the state agency to the recipient entity.

AGREEMENT

Therefore the Parties agree to this MOA as follows:

- a. The amount of the grant is \$688,000.00.
- b. DPS shall issue a check to Recipient Entity in the amount of \$344,000.00 upon completed signatures of this contract, and the remaining \$344,000.00 after January 1, 2027.
- c. The second grant distribution will only occur after the Recipient Entity delivers a status report that details the extent to which the Recipient Entity fulfilled the grant's purpose including the deliverables and performance metrics described in the Recipient Entity's document as listed in section d below.
- d. DPS acknowledges that the Recipient Entity's submitted and attached "Weber County High Utilizer Recidivism Reduction Initiative (HURRI) DPS Grant Application" is acceptable as performance metrics the Recipient Entity will produce and use to demonstrate the grant funds were used to fulfill the grant's purpose and annual deliverables.
- e. The disbursement of grant funds is subject to legislative appropriation
- f. Recipient Entity shall deliver a final report and agrees to a follow-up audit and a return of grant funds if an audit shows that the grant funds were inappropriately used.

This MOA shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Utah. Each signatory below represents that he/she has the authority to agree to all the terms of this Agreement and bind their respective entity.

This MOA is in effect as of the last date when both signatories have signed this document. This MOA remains in effect until all funds have been spent by Recipient Entity, and a final report is received by DPS.
