Subject: **First Reading of Fee Ordinance Amendments Relating to Solid Waste Fees at the Weber County Transfer Station**

Summary: This ordinance changes the minimum fee for green waste at the Weber County Transfer Station from \$10.00 to \$12.00. This change should have taken place with the approval of Ordinance 2023-03 in February 2023, which increased the general waste and construction/demolition tipping fees, and the minimum fees for each of these categories from \$10.00 to \$12.00. The green waste tipping fee did not change at that time, and therefore, the green waste minimum fee was inadvertently left at \$10.00, when it should have been changed to \$12.00 to match the other minimum fees.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. _____

FEE ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE WEBER COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

WHEREAS, Weber County reviews its solid waste fees on a regular basis, and;

WHEREAS, the green waste (compost/tree waste) minimum fee should have been changed from \$10.00 to \$12.00 in Ordinance 2023-03 to match minimum fees for general waste and C&D waste, but was inadvertently left out; and

WHEREAS, Weber County intends to correct this error by formally changing the green waste (compost/tree waste) minimum fee from \$10.00 to \$12.00; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County has determined to approve this fee change; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Title 16, Chapter 2, Section 9 of the Weber County Code shall be amended to read as follows:
