**Summary:** This ordinance adjusts the fee schedule for residential solid waste collection and disposal services currently provided by Republic Services in western Weber County and Uintah Highlands. The amendment is necessary to account for the three percent annual increase in the County's municipal materials management agreement (MMMA). In addition to the annual increase, Republic Services is requesting a fuel surcharge of \$0.57 per customer per month, as described in Section 7.3 of the MMMA. Weber County will offset the fuel surcharge by reducing the county administrative fee by \$0.57 per customer per month.

## FEE ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES (Sec 16-2-9 Solid Waste Fees)

**WHEREAS**, Republic Services is requesting an increase of three percent in solid waste collection and disposal fees as described in its municipal materials management agreement (MMMA) with Weber County for unincorporated areas of Uintah Highlands and western Weber County; and

**WHEREAS**, Republic Services is also requesting a fuel surcharge of \$0.57 per customer per month as described in Section 7.3 of the MMMA; and

**WHEREAS**, Weber County is reducing the county administrative fee by \$0.57 per customer per month to offset the increase; and

**WHEREAS**, after due consideration, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County has determined to approve such fee changes; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Title 16, Chapter 2, Section 9 of the Weber County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Dear Sean,

I am writing to officially notify you of the increase in cost to the rates below per the current contract. The contract (7.2) indicates a 3% annual escalator and (7.3) allows for a fuel surcharge that calculates out to be \$.57 per home per month for 1<sup>st</sup> cans. With these increases, the new rates adjust to the rates indicated below:

### Uintah Highlands

Current rates to their new rates

1<sup>st</sup> can - \$6.18 to ~~\$6.94~~ \$6.37    Addt'l cans - \$5.39 to \$5.55  
Billing fee - \$2.48 to \$2.55    Container delivery fee - \$14.85 to \$15.30

### West Weber

Current rates to their new rates

1<sup>st</sup> can - \$6.84 to ~~\$7.62~~ \$7.05    Addt'l cans - \$5.93 to \$6.11  
Billing fee - \$2.48 to \$2.55    Container delivery fee - \$14.85 to \$15.30
