AN ORDINANCE OF WEBER COUNTY AMENDING CERTAIN FEES TO WEBER COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received a request from Weber County Parks and Recreation Department to add and amend certain fees approved through enactment of a county ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Weber County Parks and Recreation Department has provided information to justify those fees such that the Commission finds that the fees are reasonably related to the costs involved in providing said services; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Title 16, Chapter 2, of the Weber County Fee Ordinance, shall be amended in-part to include the updated fees:
