**Summary:** This ordinance accomplishes the following purposes in amending Section 16-2-9 (Solid Waste Fees) of the Weber County Code:

- Increases the Transfer Station general waste and construction/demolition tipping fees from \$44.14 to \$50.00 per ton. This increase is in response to a 16.1% transportation increase that Republic Services received from MBI and passed on to Weber County. It also includes Republic Services' annual 3% increase for transportation and disposal services, and a small COLA increase from Weber County. Other minor amendments include increases for services, products, and delivery fees at the Transfer Station.
- Adjusts the fee schedule for residential solid waste collection and disposal services in western Weber County and Uintah Highlands. The adjustment increases the disposal fee kept by Republic Services from \$4.38 to \$4.64 per ton. This fee should have been adjusted to \$4.51 in January 2022 as part of the annual 3% increase, but was inadvertently left out.
- Corrects an error that was made on the first waste container fee increase, recently approved in December 2022. The County reduced its administrative fee by \$0.57 to offset a fuel surcharge, but the reduction was also shown on the first waste container fee, which was incorrect.

# FEE ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE WEBER COUNTY TRANSFER STATION AND RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

**WHEREAS,** Weber County received a 16.1% transportation increase from Republic Services, in addition to other costs related to the Transfer Station; and

**WHEREAS,** the Transfer Station is raising the general waste and construction/demolition tipping fees, among other increases for services, products, and deliveries to offset this increase; and

**WHEREAS,** the WACOG Solid Waste Subcommittee recommended approval of these fee increases; and

**WHEREAS,** Weber County is adjusting fees for residential solid waste collection and disposal services to correct previous mistakes; and

**WHEREAS,** after due consideration, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County has determined to approve such fee changes; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Title 16, Chapter 2, Section 9 of the Weber County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Dear Sean,

I am writing to officially notify you of the increase in cost to the rates below per the current contract. The contract (7.2) indicates a 3% annual escalator and (7.3) allows for a fuel surcharge that calculates out to be \$.57 per home per month for 1st cans. With these increases, the new rates adjust to the rates indicated below:

#### **Uintah Highlands**

Current rates to their new rates

1st can - \$6.18 to \$6.94 Addt'l cans - \$5.39 to \$5.55

Billing fee - \$2.48 to \$2.55 Container delivery fee - \$14.85 to \$15.30

#### West Weber

Current rates to their new rates

1st can - \$6.84 to \$7.62 Addt'l cans - \$5.93 to \$6.11

Billing fee - \$2.48 to \$2.55 Container delivery fee - \$14.85 to \$15.30

We will implement these new rates starting January 1, 2023.

Reece DeMille Republic Services This rate increase also raises the disposal fee kept by Republic Services from \$4.38 to \$4.64 per container as shown in Exhibit A.

The rate should have changed from \$4.38 to \$4.51 per container with the 2022 3% increase.

### **Transfer Station Transportation and Disposal Fee Increase**

A few months ago in a WACOG meeting, I discussed a pending transportation cost increase that Republic Services would receive from MBI, and in turn, pass on to the Transfer Station. At the time, I was told the increase could be as much as 40% but would likely be between 12% and 20%. Republic Services met with us just before Christmas and gave us the final number which they had negotiated with MBI: \$4.48 per ton or 16.1%. This raised the transportation and disposal cost to \$32.25 per ton.

Weber County began paying this new rate on January 1<sup>st</sup>. In response, the Transfer Station will raise its tipping fee beginning on March 1<sup>st</sup>, which gives the County time to approve a fee ordinance amendment and gives the cities and haulers time to adjust without paying the increased cost for January and February. In these two months, the Transfer Station will lose about \$161,000 (18,000 tons/month x \$4.48 x two months).

Republic Services will also charge a 3% annual increase on July  $1^{st}$  which brings the transportation and disposal cost to \$33.22 per ton. This proposal offsets the Transfer Station's loss by charging the 3% annual increase in March rather than July. This move will reimburse the County \$70,000 (18,000 tons/month x \$0.97 x four months), leaving a total loss of about \$91,000. The Transfer Station can absorb this one-time loss, but increasing the loss by charging the 3% increase in July rather than March (\$252,000 total loss) is not recommended.

The proposed new tipping fee is \$50 per ton, which includes the MBI increase, Republic's 3% annual increase, and a Transfer Station COLA increase of \$0.41 per ton. Our goal is to maintain an efficient operation and healthy fund balance, while keeping our fees as low as possible. We believe this proposal achieves that outcome. We do not anticipate an additional mid-year increase in 2023.

### **Republic/MBI Transportation Increase**

- Current Republic transportation and disposal cost: **\$27.77/ton**.
- MBI transportation cost increase beginning January 1, 2023: \$4.48/ton (16.1%).
- New Republic transportation and disposal cost: January 1<sup>st</sup> June 30<sup>th</sup> \$32.25/ton.
- Republic 3% annual increase: \$0.97/ton: July 1<sup>st</sup> December 31<sup>st</sup> \$33.22/ton.

#### **Weber County Tipping Fee Increase**

- Current Transfer Station tipping fee: \$44.14/ton.
- Republic/MBI increases: \$5.45/ton (assuming 3% increase in March instead of July).
- Weber County COLA increase \$0.41/ton.
- New Transfer Station tipping fee: \$50.00/ton (13.2% increase).



### **Transfer Station Service, Product, and Delivery Fee Increases**

### **Service Fees**

- \$10 minimum fee will increase to **\$12**.
- Special handling fee for campers, wet loads, etc. will increase from \$55 to \$65 per load.
- Fees for TV's, monitors, and other e-waste will increase from 3 items for \$10 plus weight fee to \$4 per item plus weight fee.
- Clarification that (4) tires per person and a max of (8) per vehicle per day are allowed. The cost of \$1 each plus the minimum weight fee remains the same.

Compost products and delivery services will be increased as shown in the following table:
