

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING SEWER SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, Weber County’s costs for administering and servicing sewer facilities in areas serviced by Central Weber Sewer Improvement District have increased due to various factors, including increases in the District’s fees that compose a portion of the fees charged by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to have its fees automatically updated each time the District changes its fees;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County ordains as follows:

Section 36-2-4 of the Weber County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec 36-2-4 Monthly Service Fees

A monthly service fee will be assessed for all public sewer connections in accordance with the following:

Area	Rate
Unincorporated area of the county within the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District service area	\$12.95 plus the amount of the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District service fee, currently \$27.05 as of July 1, 2022.
Unincorporated area of the county outside of the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District service area but serviced by Central Weber Sewer	\$12.95 plus the amount of the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District service fee, currently \$48.71 as of July 1, 2022.
Unincorporated area of Ogden Valley within the following service areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bailey Acres Subdivision• Basin View Subdivision• Emerson Hills Phase II Subdivision• Trappers Crossing Subdivision	\$40.00

A late fee of \$2.00 will be added to accounts that are 30 days delinquent.

This Ordinance shall be effective 15 days after publication in the Standard Examiner.
