Title 26, Chapter 2, of the Weber County Parks Ordinance, shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 26-2-1 – Prohibited Acts

No person shall engage in swimming activity or the use of canoes, kayaks, inner tubes, air mattresses, or other floating devices or allow minors in his/her charge to engage in such activity in or on Causey Reservoir, unless such person is properly wearing a Coast Guard-approved life jacket of appropriate size and which is in good and serviceable condition; or unless such person is appropriately supervised by a certified lifeguard.

Title 30, Chapter 3, Section 11, of the Weber County Public Offenses Ordinance, shall be repealed:

Sec. 30-3-11 — Swimming Restrictions at Causey Reservoir Repealed.

No person shall engage in swimming activity or the use of canoes, kayaks, inner tubes, air mattresses, or other floating devices or allow minors in his charge to engage in such activity in or on Causey Reservoir, unless such person is properly wearing a Coast Guard-approved life jacket of appropriate size and which is in good and serviceable condition.

This Ordinance shall be effective 15 days after publication in the Standard Examiner.
