

Weber County Utah Accessibility Statement

Weber County Utah is committed to providing an inclusive and accessible experience for all users, including individuals with disabilities.

Weber County is actively working toward compliance with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA standards and the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). While significant progress has been made, portions of our website may not yet fully meet accessibility standards.

Current Status

Weber County has made substantial improvements to the structure and accessibility of its website. However, some content may present accessibility challenges, including:

- Certain page structure elements that are still being refined
- Embedded third-party content, such as videos hosted on platforms like YouTube
- Other third-party tools or integrations that may not fully conform to accessibility standards

We are actively working to identify and remediate these issues as part of an ongoing effort to improve accessibility.

Ongoing Efforts

- Improving page structure, navigation, and semantic markup
- Remediating existing content and documents where feasible
- Incorporating accessibility considerations into new content and development workflows
- Providing training and guidance to staff involved in web content and development
