

EXCERPTS FROM
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES MAY 21st, 1894

Notes of Survey of County Line common to Davis and Weber Counties.

To the Hon. the Members of the County Court of Davis County, Gentlemen.

In accordance with your instructions authorizing T. H. Phillips as a member of a joint committee, consisting of two, N. W. Bethel being appointed by the County Court of Weber County as their member of said Committee, said committee being appointed to locate and mark boundary line common to Weber and Davis Counties.

We the members of said committee report the following.

The boundary line common to the above named counties is defined in Vol L. P 264. S.65 Compiled Laws of Utah and is as follows. Beginning at a point on the east shore of the Great Salt Lake, due west of a point in the center of the channel of the Weber river, due north of the North west corner of Fort Kingston, thence east to the above named point in the center of the channel of the Weber River due North of the Northwest corner of Fort Kingston, thence up the center of the channel of Weber River to a point opposite the summit of the Wasatch Mountains.

On March 29th 1894 we began to locate and mark said boundary and completed field work of same May 1st 1894.

We proceeded to Fort Kingston, and fixed a point marking the Northwest corner of said fort. From this point ran a line due north to the center of the channel of Weber River, said point marking the Northern boundary of Davis County and the Southern boundary of Weber County. Said point being further designated as Station O, marking the beginning of the line which runs due west to the east shore of Great Salt Lake.

Thence west to station 5 (Stations being 100 ft in length) at Station 5 set red sandstone 4"x4"x18" said stone being marked W C on North side and D C on south side.

Thence West to Station 45+72 at which point set red sand stone 4"x4"x18" marked WC on north side and DC on South side. Said monument being 2020⁷/₁₀ ft. North of Section Corner
