

Thence JV 36° 11' E.

along the northwesterly end line of this claim, descending, centre of "Bear Gulch Creek" draining northerly. centre of wagon road leading from La Plata town to Laramie, in a northerly course, begin to ascend the east side of the gulch. Set a pine post 4" x 4" x 4 ft. long 12" in the ground and mound of stones 2 ft. high and 4 ft. base, and marked the same U.S. 40. P. 3. for corner N 3° 3'. Set a pine post 4" x 4" x 4 ft. long 12" in the ground and mound of stones 2 ft. high and 4 ft. base, and marked the same U.S. 40. P. 3. for corner N 3° 3'. whence the most northerly location post of this claim found standing in place bears JV 36° 11' E. 50 ft. distant. A pine stump 3 ft. high, blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 3. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears N 34° W 29 ft. An aspen tree 6" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 3. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears N 7° 30' W. 57 ft. The centre of the mouth of the Alma Tunnel, bears JV 53° W. 122 ft. distant actual measurement. The centre of the mouth of the Red Jacket Tunnel bears N 33° 06' W. 193 ft. distant, actual measurement.

Thence S 48° 59' E.

along the easterly side line of the claim, ascending, top of ridge, bearing northerly and southerly; thence descending, intersect the Quarter Section line 242.76 ft. JV 89° 50' W. from the Quarter Section corner on the east line of sec. H. Twp. 8 N - R. 2 E. by calculate. Set a pine post 4" x 4" x 4 ft. long 12" in the ground and mound of stones, 2 ft. high and 4 ft. base, and marked the same U.S. 40. P. 4. for corner N 3° 4. which is identical with the most easterly location post of this claim found standing in place. A pine tree 30" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 4. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears JV 18° E 18 ft. A pine tree 24" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 4. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears S 80° E 107 ft.

Thence S 36° 11' W.

along the southerly end line of the claims, descending, centre of wagon road leading westerly to La Plata Town, thence ascending Post P. of this claim, the place of beginning.

Description of the boundaries and corners of the "RED JACKET LODE."

Beginning at the identical place of discovery where a notice is posted, identified by affidavit filed herewith, I set a pine post 4" x 4" x 4 ft. long firmly in the ground and mound of stones 2 ft. high and 4 ft. base, and marked the same U.S. Lot 40. D. 15. From this point a pine tree 15" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked D. 15. 40. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears N 48° 10' E. 33.8 ft. A pine tree 8" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked D. 15. 40. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears N. 73° 30' E. 40. Ft. From this discovery post a shaft 6 x 6 ft. square and 7 ft. deep. bears S 38° 58' E 15. ft. distant. The east gable of J. P. Law's store in La Plata bears and Post Office building in La Plata, bears S 19° 35' E.

Thence I run JV 36° 11' E
to the centre of the vein.

Thence I run JV 28° 56' W.

along the centre of the vein,
to the Northwesterly end line of the claim,

Thence I run S 28° 56' E.

along the centre of the vein,
to the south-easterly end line of this claim, and to the North-westerly end line of the "Queen of the Hills" Lode.

Thence S. 36° 11' W.

along the south-easterly end line of this claim, and along the north-westerly end line of the "Queen of the Hills" claim, which is identical with the most southerly location post of this claim; I therefore mark this post on its northerly face U.S. L. 40. P. 5. for corner N 3° 5. A pine tree 8" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 2. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears S 10° W 29.6 ft. A pine tree 8" diam. blazed 2 ft. above ground and marked 40. P. 2. and on a blaze 1 ft. above ground marked B.T. bears S 32° 20' E 28.7 ft.
