 Ascending over stony ground
 top of ridge 250 ft above the sec. cr., bears N 60° W. + S. 60° E.
 Steep descent, over broken ground sloping N 2°
 Spur sloping N.E. Begin steep descent, into West
 fork of Black Hawk canon.

Set quartzite boulder stone 18 x 8 x 6 ins 12 ins in the
 ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked "Men W. face" and raised
 a mound of stone 2 ft base, 1 1/2 ft high W. of cor.
 Pits impracticable.
 Bottom of N. fork of Black Hawk Canon. 400 ft below
 the top ridge, course N 50° E. with small
 springs rise and flow N.E. Begin ascent of West

Set trap 1/4 sec. cor.
 Intersect E. bdry of Sp. at the cor. of sec's. 1-6-7 + 12, which
 is a white sandstone 6 x 6 x 6 ins above ground, firmly
 set, marked and cut into as described by the survivor
 general.
 Hence I run

W. on a bury line bet. Sec's. 1 and 12.

ascending over broken ground, S. side of
 Sp. of ascent, start N 45° S. Hence over broken ground sloping
 S. side of Cedar Canon.

Enter oak brush, N & S.
 Leave
 descent into Black Hawk canon. N 45° W.
 Set gray sand stone 15 x 10 x 5 ins 10 ins in the ground
 for 1/4 sec. cor. marked "Men N. face" and raised a mound
 of stone 1 1/2 ft high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
