Bearings from said point being as follows, to Eagle Peak $8.68^{\circ} 34' E.$ to the chimney on the North Ogden meeting house $8.78^{\circ} 05' S.$ and to the chimney on the South end of the Hot Springs Hotel $N. 63^{\circ} 07' E.$ The total length of said road is 178.62 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading southerward from Ogden City to Utah District.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of Main Street at the South end of Ogden City 12.16 chains West and 11.87 chains North from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Five, Township Five North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, bearing and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 48 "South end of the Weber County Base" ^{with dimensions 8" x 18" x 48"} the bearings from said monument are as follows, to Observatory Peak $76.87^{\circ} 52' E.$ to Bonlomond Peak $N. 2^{\circ} 08' E.$ to the spire on the Weber County Court House $N. 2^{\circ} 49' E.$ and to the U. S. Beginning at a point 21.72 chains West and 1.32 chains South from the North East corner of Section Twenty Seven Township Five North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which point the bearing to the West gable of the school house at Unitah is $S.75^{\circ}20'E.$ - running from thence due South in the center of said road 12.87 chains, thence West 2.25 chains, thence South 2.30 chains, to a point on the South side of the Railway Station at Unitah. Said road being 17.43 chains in length.

Description of a County Road eight rods wide leading Southward from Ogden City, through Rivendale District and to the Southern boundary line of Weber County.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of Main Street in the southern part of Ogden City 12.16 chains West and 111.89 chains North from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section No. Five, Township Five North, of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 48, at the South end of the Weber County base. At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 24th
 day of April, A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 on page 461, &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

The following communication from County Surveyor
 Postapf was received and read now:—
 The undersigned, your engineer would respectfully report that he, on April 25th 1899, examined a public road leading from Vinta in a northerly direction to the top of Weber River hill, that he finds the grade of the present road at one point 33 ft rise to 100 feet distance. That the grade of the road is too steep to permit hauling a reasonable wagon load up the same. That he can find no way to reduce the grade materially without rebuilding the road on a new line.

That he surveyed a new line for a road commencing near the residence of Mr. Le Gausne and running around the side hill to near the lands of

Mr. Nottel, immediately north of the County Bridge across Weber river. The road as surveyed will have a grade of six feet to each 100 ft. distance, and can be constructed as cheaply as any road can be built on the side hill. The length of the new line is 4700 feet, any increase or decrease of grade of one foot to each 100 feet will not materially increase or decrease the cost of the construction.

3600 ft. is on the hill-side, 1100 on sage brush lands.
