

## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 2<sup>nd</sup>  
 day of October A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
 on page 181 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Commissioner Sken, to whom was re-  
 ferred the petition of C. T. Middleton et al, praying for  
 the opening of a road from the west end of 21<sup>st</sup> St. to Wilson's  
 Lane on the north side of the Rio Grande Western Railroad  
 Company's tracks, reported that the County Surveyor had  
 made the survey of the proposed road and that the right-  
 of-way for the said road could be purchased from Mr.  
 James B. Stone for the sum of \$75<sup>00</sup> through his premises  
 in Section 36, Twp. 6 North of Range 1 West, and rec-  
 ommended that the road as petitioned for be open-  
 ed to the public and that the sum of \$75<sup>00</sup> be paid to  
 Mr. Stone for a right of way across his premises as  
 surveyed by the County Surveyor, upon his executing  
 the necessary conveyance, and that upon his  
 so doing, the County Auditor, be directed to draw  
 his warrant in favor of Mr. Stone for \$75<sup>00</sup>. The  
 recommendation of the committee was unanimous-  
 ly adopted and approved.
