

**COVID GUIDELINES:** \*subject to change at any time.

**FACEMASKS ARE REQUIRED FOR EVERY PERSON ENTERING AND REMAINING IN THE FACILITY, THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS CHILDREN TWO YEARS OF AGE AND YOUNGER. MASKS MUST BE WORN CORRECTLY AT ALL TIMES, COVERING BOTH THE MOUTH AND THE NOSE. PLAYERS AND OFFICIALS MAY REMOVE THEIR MASKS DURING PLAY. IF ANY TEAM DOES NOT FOLLOW THE MASK MANDATE, WE WILL BE REQUIRED TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF SPECTATORS IN THE BUILDING TO ONE SPECTATOR PER PLAYER FOR THAT TEAM.**

PRIOR TO GAME TIME: Coaches are required to check with their teams the day of their game to check for any signs of illness or contact with anyone that may be ill, experiencing any signs of being sick or may have a fever. If they are showing signs of illness or have a fever, they are NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE FACILITY, even as a spectator. This includes players, coaches and spectators. Remind players to bring their masks and a water bottle with their name on it.

FACILITY ENTRY: Everyone will be required to enter the building ***IN FACEMASKS***, through the north entrance. In order to minimize exposure and to maintain social distancing, entrances will be locked and our night supervisor will open the doors to let players, coaches and spectators in. Doors will be marked with which entrance you will use. At no time will entrance doors be unlocked, we will hold doors open to allow you to enter and then doors will be closed behind you. Anyone running late will need to call a coach or someone to let them in as there will not be anyone staffed to watch for late players. We will have hand sanitizer at the entrance. Please have each person use the sanitizer upon entry. We ask that coaches please bring their own sanitizer to use on the bench as needed.

GAME DURATION: During the game, coaches and players on the bench (since 6 feet social distancing cannot be maintained) and all spectators, will need to be in face masks. The Governor has required anyone in a state building or office to be in a facemask (this includes our facilities). Players may take off their masks when they go on the court but will need to put it back on when they are on the team bench. The ONE coach that stands may remove his/her mask while standing in the coach's box but must put mask on for team huddles and when sitting on the team bench.

NO HANDSHAKE ZONE: We ask that there be no handshakes, high-fives, hugging, etc. to your own teammates or to the other team before, during or after the game. We highly encourage sportsmanship by clapping for the other team at the conclusion of the game, thanking coaches and referees, etc. but highly discourage any kind of contact. Spitting anywhere inside the building is not allowed at any time. Please do not allow players to lick their hand and then wipe the bottom of their shoes. Coaches may bring a sticky mat for players to use. Courts will be swept between games to help with slippery courts.

GAME CONCLUSION: ***PLEASE COLLECT ALL BELONGS AT THE END OF YOUR GAME***— WATER BOTTLES WILL BE THROWN AWAY AND NOT KEPT IN THE LOST AND FOUND! In order to clear the building and sanitize for the next games, we ask that you take your teams outside to do your team meetings after the games. Time between games is limited and it is mandatory that we sanitize between games. PLEASE HELP US WITH THIS!

Exit doors will be marked, please use one of the two exit doors that are marked for your court. The teams playing on court 1, the east court, will need to exit through the east doors. Teams playing on court 2, the west court, will need to exit through the west doors. These will be the only exit doors. Once teams have cleared out, employees will sanitize basketballs, team chairs and bleachers. The next teams will then be allowed to enter the building through the north doors only.

We understand these guidelines may make games run a little behind and cut down on warm up and/or half time but sanitizing is our top priority and must be done.
